Iprovalicarb did not cause specific target organ toxicity in experimental animal studies.

## Assessment mutagenicity

Propineb was not mutagenic or genotoxic based on the overall weight of evidence in a battery of in vitro and in vivo tests.

Iprovalicarb was not mutagenic or genotoxic in a battery of in vitro and in vivo tests.

## Assessment carcinogenicity

Propineb caused an increased incidence of tumours in mice in the following organ(s): Liver. The mechanism that triggers tumours in rodents and the type of tumours observed are not relevant to humans. Iprovalicarb was not carcinogenic in lifetime feeding studies in rats and mice.

#### Assessment toxicity to reproduction
